1. This is the second petition filed under Section 483 of BNSS/439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 204 dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 351(2)(3) of BNS (Section 506 of IPC) and Section 6 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1).

2. Custody certificate has been filed by the State, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and has already undergone actual custody for a period of 02 years and 15 days.

4. *Per contra*, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner. He, on instructions from the investigating officer concerned, submits that the trial is at its concluding stage as the charges were framed on 23.07.2024 and, out of 16 cited prosecution witnesses, 15 have already been examined.

5. In view of the submissions made above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn.

- 7. However, the learned trial Court is encouraged to conclude the trial expeditiously.
