SHEEL NAGU. J.(Oral)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 read with Section 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for the following reliefs:-

“(a) Direct the Respondent authorities to take appropriate legal and disciplinary action against Respondent Nos. 2 to 6 for gross abuse of process of law, coercion, and violation of the petitioner's fundamental rights during the recording of cross-examination.

(b) Direct the respondent to re-record the cross examination of the witness of the Petitioner and DW1 which has been recorded violating the fundamental right.

(c) To stay the further proceeding of the case during the pendency of the present petition.”

2. The grievance of the petitioner, who happens to be plaintiff in Civil Suit No.1076-2017, is to take disciplinary action against respondents No.2 to 6 for gross abuse of the process of law, coercion and violation of the petitioner's fundamental rights during the recording of cross-examination.

3. The respondents herein are six in number, including one Judicial



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Officer and four Advocates.

4. When this Court invited the attention of the learned counsel for the petitioner to the order dated 20.11.2025 passed in Civil Suit No.1076 of 2017 by the respondent No.2, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that no objection with respect to contents of the cross-examination were raised.
5. In view of the above, it is obvious that this is an attempt towards vilification of the judicial officer which needs to be dealt with heavy hands.
6. Accordingly, this petition stands dismissed with costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh, within a period of seven days.
