1) On the last date of hearing, i.e. 17.11.2025, this Court had
passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petition/State, apprises this Court, that during the pendency of the instant petition, unfortunately, the demise of the respondent No.1/workman, has occurred, and therefore, the question of re-instatement does not survives. He further submits that now the limited question which has been left to be adjudicated, is with regard to 50% back wages.

Further, he has made a request for an adjournment, to have apt instructions, from the quarter concerned, as to whether, the petitioner still wishes to pursue the instant petition. In case, the petitioner wishes to pursue the instant matter, it is directed that LR's of deceased/respondent No.1, be impleaded, on or before the next date of hearing.

List this matter on 12.05.2025, for arguments.

Needful be done on or before the next date of hearing.”

- 3) In view of the above, the petition is **dismissed, being not pressed.**
