1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from illegal harassment, coercion and intimidation at the hands of respondent no.4 in connivance with respondent no.5 with a further prayer to direct the respondent no. 2 and 3 to conduct an inquiry into the illegal acts and conduct of respondent No.4 and direct the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 12.05.2026 (Annexure P-2).

2. The petitioner, at the very outset submits that for his grievance, he has already submitted a representation dated 12.05.2026 to the Director General of Police (DGP) Punjab Police, Chandigarh, but no action has been taken thereon so far. At this stage, the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if his representation dated 12.05.2026 (Annexure P-2) is decided by the authorities in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, A.A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the Director General of Police (DGP) Punjab Police, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and take the necessary action as per law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
6. Petition stands disposed of.
