1. Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of order dated 15.04.2026 as well as report dated 29.01.2026 vide which registration of an FIR has been directed against the petitioners, along with setting aside of all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, being wholly without jurisdiction, contrary to settled principles of law, and liable to be set aside.
2. After arguing for some time, learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that he wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail their alternative remedy as available to them, as per law.
3. Allowed as prayed for. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
