1. Present civil revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order of Additional District Judge, Bhiwani dated 25.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) as well as the order dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tosham.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present revision petition arises from the proceedings under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC read with Section 151 CPC, whereas, the main suit itself has been dismissed in default under Order 9 Rule 8 CPC, vide order dated 17.12.2025 and has thus prayed that the present revision petition be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the present revision petition in case the suit is restored or any cause survives.
