SANJAY VASHISTH, J (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking grant of regular bail, in case, FIR No.196, dated 29.08.2024, under Sections 103(1), 140(1), 190, 191(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station New Colony, District Gurugram.

2. After hearing the submissions addressed by counsel for the petitioner, on 01.07.2025, following order was passed:-

"2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that in the present case incident took place on 28.08.2024 at around 10:00 am. It is submitted that now deceased, Naresh Kumar, in an injured condition, personally reported to Sethi Hospital, wherein it was recorded as:

"A/H/O – Slip form bike (by self) at ... on 28.08.2024, at around 10:00 am."

3. He submits that it is a case where no MLC was registered as the injured himself stated that injuries have been suffered due to his own mistake and, therefore, he did not want to initiate any police action. Accordingly, he was discharged from the hospital on the same day. However, continuing his submissions, Mr. Dalal submits that on 28.08.2024, at about 2:00

pm, the deceased was again admitted in Paras Healthcare Private Limited, Sector 43, Gurugram. Wherein, it was got recorded as:

“A/H/O assault by unknown persons (around 3-4 persons) at around 1:30 pm.”

4. It is further submitted that FIR in question has been registered on account of the alleged incident, having taken place at 2:00 pm. In the said FIR, allegations have been levelled against the petitioner Rambeer @ Rambir, along with other 6-7 persons. It is not in dispute that the petitioner has been in custody since 03.09.2024. On the strength of the aforementioned grounds, Mr. Dalal prays for the grant of bail to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Dharam Pal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court on advance, accepts notice and prays for time to file a status report.

Adjourned to 30.09.2025.”

3. While referring to the status report dated 29.09.2025, already appended with the present petition, learned State counsel submits that the prosecution is in possession of a video recording of the incident, wherein the accused can be seen inflicting injuries with weapons i.e. sticks, screwdriver (*pechkas*), and hammer.
4. Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, at this stage.
5. Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
