1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P-14), vide which, the claim of the petitioner for designation as Assistant Professor/Lecturer has been declined on the ground that the petitioner does not have the requisite qualification required for the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioner has already attained the age of superannuation i.e. 58 years and has retired on 28.02.2018 from the post of Technical Officer. He further submits that even, for the sake of the arguments, if it is presumed that the petitioner is held entitled for designation of Assistant Professor/Lecturer, even then, the petitioner has attained the age of superannuation i.e. 65 years and cannot be

Professor/Lecturer is 65 years. Learned counsel submits that taking into consideration the abovesaid facts, the present petition may be disposed of as rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for revival of the same, if any cause still survives.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as rendered infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
