HARPREET SINGH BRAR, J (Oral):

The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ or order in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to remove the anomaly in the pay of the petitioner viz-a-viz his Junior Harpal Singh to step up the pay of the petitioner so as to bring it at par with the pay of the Junior Harpal Singh as the benefit has not been granted to him inspite of the fact that the case was processed and recommended at all stages in various offices of the respondents and only a formal order is required to be issued and with a further prayer to re-fix/revise the pay and pensionary benefits of the petitioner with all consequential benefits including arrears of pay and allowances and to release the same along with interest @ 12% per annum from the due date till the date of actual payment.

2. Today, the present case was called twice, but none has put in appearance on behalf of petitioner. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution, so also the pending miscellaneous application, if any.
