VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ for quashing the order dated 06.08.2015, whereby *interalia* a penalty of Rs.25,000/- was imposed against the petitioner.
2. On 03.05.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time to implead LR's of respondent No. 2.
3. Again on, 11.10.2023, time was sought to comply with the abovesaid order. Till date, no LR's of respondent No. 2 have been impleaded and the case is of the year 2015.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not in touch with his client and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but has prayed that liberty

be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case in case any cause survives alongwith the application for bringing on record the LRs of respondent No. 2.

5. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
