The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeks issuance of directions to the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal-cum-Executing Court to decide the execution proceedings in *Execution No. 150 of 2025*, titled “*Suresh Kumar Versus Oriental Insurance Company Ltd.*” within a time bound period.

[2] I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

[3] A perusal of record shows that execution application (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner in May 2025 is still pending and the petitioner is waiting to get amount of compensation.

[4] In view of above, the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal-cum-Executing Court is requested to decide / dispose of the aforesaid Execution Petition as expeditiously as possible, as per law, preferably within a period of six months from today, as any further delay is

going to cause serious prejudice to the rights of petitioner.

[5] Petition stands **disposed off** accordingly.

[6] Keeping in view the nature of proceedings, the present petition is being decided without issuing notice to the respondent, lest it may delay the proceedings before the learned Executing Court and may also burden it with unnecessary costs towards litigation expenses.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
