1. Prayer in the present petition is for extension of time for furnishing bail bonds pursuant to order dated 15.10.2025 passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Amritsar in FIR No.36 dated 02.05.2023, registered under Sections 22/29/51/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner the petitioner was granted benefit of default bail by learned trial Court vide order dated 15.10.2025 and he was directed to furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1 lac with one surety of the like amount within a period of 24 hours i.e. till 01:00 p.m. of 16.10.2025 to furnish the bail bonds and surety bonds. He further submits that however, the order was not uploaded on the website of the Court, and due to which he could not furnish the bail bonds within the stipulated period. He fairly submits that the petitioner is involved in two other cases and thus, he could not appear before the Court for extension of time. He further submits that the father of the petitioner expired on 11.05.2026, and the Bhog ceremony is scheduled to be held tomorrow, i.e. 20.05.2026. Therefore, the presence of the petitioner is required there.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ekompal Sagoo, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He has opposed the submission made by counsel for the petitioner.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, particularly the fact that the father of the petitioner expired on 11.05.2026 and the Bhog ceremony is scheduled on 20.05.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to grant limited time to the petitioner to furnish the requisite bail bonds. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner shall furnish the bail bonds and surety bonds, as directed by the learned trial Court vide order dated 15.10.2025, within a period of three days from today, subject to satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

6. It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to furnish the requisite bonds within the aforesaid period, the benefit granted by this order shall automatically stand withdrawn.
