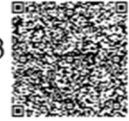

DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

(1) Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the orders passed by respondent No.3 dated 09.02.2026 and 13.02.2026, the petitioner has filed an appeal before respondent No.2 which is pending since February 2026 and in the meanwhile, the petitioner is not being able to earn his livelihood. Therefore, a prayer is made for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to expeditiously dispose of the petitioner's aforesaid appeal.

(2) Learned State counsel has no objection to the acceptance of the aforesaid prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.



(3) In the facts of this case, we find the afore prayer made on behalf of the petitioner to be reasonable and therefore, dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to dispose of the petitioner's appeal filed by it to challenge therein the orders passed by respondent No.3 dated 09.02.2026 and 13.02.2026, by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to all affected parties, preferably within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.
