The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the office order dated 20.11.2024, Annexure P-8, whereby the petitioner's last pay drawn has been reduced from ₹38,300 to ₹31,400, as also the due retiral benefits on that basis. Apparently, the order has been passed without issuing any show cause notice or affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the University, on instructions, submits that it has been decided to reconsider the issue of refixation of the petitioner's pay and pass a fresh order after affording an opportunity of hearing to her.

3. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of, setting aside the office order dated 20.11.2024 with liberty to the University to pass a fresh reasoned order after issuing a show cause notice to the petitioner and taking her response thereto into account, in accordance with law.
