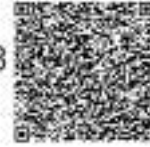

MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Prayer in this petition has been made for quashing of order dated 23.04.2026 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Faridabad in case arising out of FIR No. 413 dated 06.06.2022 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323 and 506 of IPC at Police Station Sector 58, District Faridabad, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for preponing the hearing of the case had been dismissed.

2. On a perusal of the impugned order, it is revealed that the petitioner, who is the complainant in the case pending before the trial Court, had made a request for preponing the hearing of the case on the ground that the cross-case bearing FIR No. 188 dated 04.01.2023 was pending before the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Faridabad on 22.05.2026 and by submitting that the present case pending before the concerned Court was to be decided

along with the same. Learned trial Court declined this prayer by observing that the case pending before the Sessions Court was at the stage of defence evidence, whereas the instant case was at the stage of producing evidence by the prosecution only.

3. It is also mentioned that the FIR of both these cases have been lodged after a considerable gap of time and the petitioner could not claim as a matter of right that both the cases pending before different courts were to be decided together. There is also no material on record to show that they are cross cases. As such, this Court finds no reason to interfere with the order of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad which is even otherwise an interlocutory order. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

4. Since the main petition has already been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
