1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ, order of direction, especially in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondent No. 1 to 4 to provide protection of life, and dignity and protection of property of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 8 and to take appropriate action against them as per law with a further prayer for directing respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to transfer/entrust the investigation of FIR No. 85 dated 17.04.2026, Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, under Sections 329, 62, 351(2), 3(5) BNS, (Sections 441/447/448, 511, 506 and 34 IPC) and all connected complaints/counter-complaints arising out of the same property dispute, including the complaint filed by respondent No. 7 to a senior police officer not below the rank of ACP/DSP, preferably under the supervision of an IPS officer/DCP/ADCP Investigation, or to a Special Investigation Team. It has been further prayed that respondent No.2 be directed to take immediate action on the representation dated 02.05.2026 (Annexure P/10).

2. The petitioner, at the very outset submits that for his grievance, he has already submitted a representation dated 02.05.2026 to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, but no action has been taken thereon so far. At this stage, the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if his representation dated 02.05.2026 (Annexure P-10) is decided by the authorities in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Surinderjit Singh Nahar, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-10) of the petitioner and take the necessary action as per law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. Petition stands disposed of.
