Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of Mandamus for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners endangered at the hands of accused persons and to conduct a fair and impartial investigation, in FIR No.105 dated 06.05.2026, registered under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 324(4), 191(3) of the BNS, 2023, at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar registered against the accused persons.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar or a responsible officer deputed by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider and take a

conscious decision on the pending representation dated 18.05.2026 (Annexure P-8) made by the petitioners.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Adhiraj Singh Thind, AAG Punjab causes appearance and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He submits that grievance of the petitioners will be looked into by respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar or a responsible officer deputed by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and shall take decision either way, on the pending representation dated 18.05.2026 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition in hand is **disposed of** with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar or a responsible officer deputed by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider pending representation dated 18.05.2026 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioners and take a ratiocinated decision thereupon, within a period of 15 days from today, in accordance with law.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
