1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to install new commercial connection.

2. As per pleadings, the petitioner has applied for 8 KW commercial connection from the answering respondents for his car washing point at Sangrur-Barnala highway. He has deposited fee of Rs.2,33,030/- through demand draft dated 09.02.2026. The respondent has not released electricity connection despite expiry of 3 months from the date of deposit of fee. He has served legal notice dated 23.04.2026 upon respondents but to no avail.

3. Mr. T.S. Sidhu, Advocate has filed memo of appearance on behalf of respondent-PSPCL. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.
4. Learned counsel for respondent submits that competent authority would consider petitioner's claim and address his grievance within six weeks from today.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.
6. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
7. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
