KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

- 1) At the outset, learned Senior counsel appearing for the respondent-Institute has handed over all the documents, including the provisional degree to the learned counsel for the petitioner, today in the Court, and submits that the instant writ petition is rendered infructuous.
- 2) Learned counsel for the petitioner, upon receipt of the said documents, expresses an apprehension that, the provisional degree is valid up till six months only. Therefore, in case, the original degree is not supplied within six months, the petitioner would be compelled to approach this Court again, on the same cause of action.
- 3) Learned Senior counsel for the respondent-Institute submits that he has instructions to inform this Court that the process of convocation is in the offing. And, in any case, the original degree will be handed over to the petitioner before expiry of the provisional degree.



- 4) In view of the above, nothing substantial remains to be adjudicated, and thus, the proceedings are closed. However, in the event, the needful is not done, in terms of the statement made by learned Senior counsel the respondent-Institute, the petitioner is at liberty to get the instant writ petition revived, by filing an apt motion. It is also clarified that the questions of law involved in the present petition are left open to be decided in appropriate proceedings.
- 5) Needless to assert that the respondent-Institute would also be at liberty to resort to the remedial measures, in accordance with law, in case of any violation as regards the bond/affidavit submitted by the petitioner.
- 6) **Disposed of**, accordingly.
