1. By way of filing the instant petition, violation of the judgment dated 31.12.2025 (Annexure P-1), passed by this Court in CWP-8001-2025, has been alleged.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and informs that LPA-1092-2026 has been decided vide order dated 15.05.2026. Copy of the said order has been submitted in the Court today, which is taken on record.
4. As per the aforesaid order, the State has been directed to examine individual cases of the respondents-writ petitioners for regularization, keeping in view the policy mentioned therein. It has been further directed that *status quo* with regard to the working of the employees would be maintained till the orders are passed by the authorities.



5. Learned State counsel stated that the case of the petitioner shall be considered in the light of the aforesaid order passed by the Division Bench of this Court.
6. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is **disposed of** at this stage having rendered **infructuous**. In case no decision is taken within six months by the respondents in the matter of the petitioner, in terms of the aforesaid order passed in the LPA, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of this petition or file a afresh petition.
7. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
