1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the retiral benefits of her deceased husband who expired on 22.12.2022.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the husband of the petitioner who was working on the post of Head Constable expired on 22.12.2022 however, till date no retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner. Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Rohit Ahuja, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 23.03.2026 (Annexure P-1), submitted by the petitioner within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
