1. The instant petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, has been filed for quashing of the impugned order dated 06.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited and he has been summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest in case FIR No.94 dated 04.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) under Section 21 (b) and Section 27 of NDPS Act added later on, registered at P.S. City, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. On 01.07.2025, the following order was passed:

“The instant petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, has been filed for quashing of the impugned order dated 06.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited and he has been summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest in case FIR No.94 dated 04.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) under Section 21 (b) and Section 27 of NDPS Act added later on, registered at P.S. City, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. *Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner, after being granted concession of bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) vide Annexure P-2 dated 05.08.2023 had been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court to face the trial in case 'State of Punjab Versus Sourav alias Prince' bearing NDPS No.321 of 2023, pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib. He submits that on 06.09.2024, the petitioner could not put in appearance on account of having wrongly noted the date leading to cancellation of his bail and issuance of non-bailable warrants of arrest. He further submits that the case is now pending for 11.07.2025 for the presence of the petitioner as per the last order dated 06.03.2025 annexed on the file. He submits that if granted concession of bail, the petitioner will regularly appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing without fail. Hence, the petition.*

3. *Notice of motion.*

4. *On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual matrix of the case.*

5. *Be it the case, without commenting on the merits of the case at this stage, the petitioner is hereby directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to deposit of Rs.10,000/- as cost with the District Legal Services Authority, Sri Muktsar Sahib, as a condition precedent for his admission to interim bail.*

6. *The petitioner is further directed to furnish specific undertaking before the concerned Court that he will regularly appear on each and every date of hearing and in case of any exigency, he will seek exemption from the Court in accordance with law.*

7. *The trial Court is directed to communicate the order on the appearance of the petitioner, to this Court immediately, through appropriate channel well before the next date of hearing.*

8. *List on 18.07.2025."*

3. It is not in dispute before this Court that the petitioner has caused appearance before the concerned trial Court, in terms of order dated 01.07.2025 earlier passed by this Court.

3. In view thereof, the order dated 01.07.2025 is hereby made absolute.
