1. Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect the petitioners and their family members from alleged illegal threats and harassment by respondent Nos. 6 to 9. It is further pleaded that despite repeated complaints, including complaints dated 20.09.2025 (Annexure P-1) and 01.02.2026 (Annexure P-3), no action has been taken and the petitioner is being harassed by the local police (respondent No. 5) at the instance of private respondents, thereby endangering the petitioner's life, liberty, and property.

2. It is also prayed that respondent Nos. 2 to 4 be directed to take action on the complaints in accordance with law and the guidelines laid down in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. Writ Petition 2014 (1) SCC (Cri) 524* and to ensure registration and investigation of cognizable offences. Any other appropriate order deemed fit is also prayed for.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 20.09.2025 (Annexure P-1) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, however no action has been taken on the same till date.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sahil Chowdhary, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to decide the representation dated 20.09.2025 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner, qua threat perception in accordance with law within a period of one month from today and grant immediate protection, if any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, is perceived.

7. It is being clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner for legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.

8. Pending application(s), if any, is/are disposed of.
