1 Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking an appropriate writ, order or direction for setting aside the illegal manner of implementation of order dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-6), specifically the creation of additional *Nakka(s)*.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that as regards the relief claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have moved the representation dated 27.03.2026 (Annexure P-12), but the same has not been adverted to by the concerned authorities, till date. She submits that petitioners would be satisfied, if time bound directions are issued to respondent No.2 – Punjab State Tubewell Corporation Limited (PSTC), Malerkotla/competent Authority to decide aforesaid representation dated 27.03.2026 (Annexure P-12).

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3. At this stage, Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of the respondent-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him, and submits that respondent No.2 – Punjab State Tubewell Corporation Limited (PSTC), Malerkotla/competent Authority shall take decision either way, on the aforesaid representation dated 27.03.2026 (Annexure P-12), within a period of six weeks from today.

4. Keeping in view the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Punjab State Tubewell Corporation Limited (PSTC), Malerkotla/competent Authority, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 27.03.2026 (Annexure P-12), in accordance with law, by way of passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from today, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
