1. The present Criminal Revision Petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 17.01.2007 passed by the then Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Zira, whereby petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment (for short 'R.I.') for a period of two years alongwith fine of Rs.1500/- as well as the judgment dated 15.02.2008 passed by the then learned Sessions Judge, Ferozepur dismissing the appeal preferred by the petitioner while upholding the judgment and order dated 17.01.2007.

2. Status report dated 01.12.2025 is already on record. As per it, the petitioner Surjit Singh has already expired on 29.08.2015. It also accompanies his death certificate issued by Civil Surgeon, Moga.

3. A perusal of trial Court record shows that the petitioner had paid the fine imposed upon him in the case in question on 17.01.2007 itself.

There is an order of that date passed by the concerned Magistrate in that

regard in the file uploaded on DMS portal of this Court.



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4. Through the impugned judgment(s) and order, the petitioner was sentenced to undergo R.I. for 2 years and to pay a fine of Rs.1500/- for the offence punishable under Section 409 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. In default of payment of fine, he was ordered to undergo further R.I. for 3 months.
5. Since the petitioner has expired and imposed fine had been paid, the present petition stands abated.
6. It is disposed of as abated. Pending application(s), if any, is/are also disposed of.
