Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking setting aside of order dated 13.7.2022 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby application filed by the petitioner under Section 227 of CrPC for discharging him was dismissed and charge was framed.

Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab, submits that matter has been investigated by a Special Investigation Team consisting of ADCP- PB-I, ACP -East and ACP Special Crime. The SIT found 10 persons innocent and petitioner was found guilty. Accordingly, challan has been presented against the petitioner. Charges have already been framed and now petitioner is facing trial which is pending before Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. The next date of hearing is 22.11.2022 and matter is fixed for prosecution evidence.

In view of statement of learned State counsel, no further order is warranted.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
