1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, for setting aside the order dated 19.09.2017 (Annexure P-13), whereby the representation of the petitioners has been rejected, though the petitioners are entitled for regularisation in view of instructions dated 18.03.2011 (Annexure P-10) as well as the Punjab Ad Hoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employees' Welfare Act, 2016, as the petitioners fulfil all the conditions enumerated therein.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Jujhar Singh, Belt No.791, Office of DIG, Patiala Circle, submits that services of all the petitioners have already been regularised and, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite his

best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.

4 In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
