1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the death-cum-retiral and pensionary benefits pertaining to the deceased son of the petitioner, namely Rupinderjit Singh.

2. Learned counsel submits that the daughter-in-law of the petitioner has now got remarried as such, the petitioner is entitled for grant of family pension. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner has also served a legal notice dated dated 22.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) in respect of grant of pensionary benefits.

3. Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.4 to decide the legal notice dated 22.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) served by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

5. Mr. Rohit Ahuja, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.04.2026 (Annexure P-5), served by the petitioner within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law/rules.
