HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the Show Cause Notice/proposed demolition action dated 27.02.2026 (Annexure P-5), issued under Sections 261(1) and 262(1) of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all their pleas, as raised in the instant writ petition, in

response to the Show Cause Notice/proposed demolition action dated 27.02.2026 (Annexure P-5), before respondent No.4 – Joint Commissioner-II, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram. However, he prays that time bound directions may be issued for the decision on the Show Cause Notice/proposed demolition action dated 27.02.2026 (Annexure P-5), issued under Sections 261(1) and 262(1) of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994.

3. Learned State counsel as well as learned senior counsel for respondents No.3 to 5 have raised no objection to the aforesaid course being adopted.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

5. It goes without saying that in case the petitioner approaches respondent No.4 – Joint Commissioner-II, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram within a period of two weeks from today, then the Joint Commissioner-II, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram/competent authority is directed to conclude the proceedings in question within a period of six weeks thereafter.

6. The present writ petition is disposed of in the aforestated terms.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
