1. The present petition has been filed that though execution petition has been filed before the Armed Forces Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench (for short – the ‘Tribunal’), the relief is yet to be granted which is causing prejudice especially when the execution application is liable to be decided within a period of six months, which judgment of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India in *Periyammal (Dead) and others versus V. Rajamani and another*, 2025 INSC 329 has not been followed.

4. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

5. Considering the nature of relief being sought in the writ petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Tribunal to take necessary

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steps to dispose of the execution application filed by the petitioner by passing a final order, in accordance with law within a period of three months from the next date of hearing.
