1. The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS is for grant of interim bail for six weeks to the petitioner on medical ground in case FIR No.164 dated 17.06.2023 under Sections 302, 307, 212, 506/34, 120-B IPC 1860 (Sections 103, 109, 249, 351(2), 3(5), 61 BNS) and Sections 25 (1-b) (a) and 54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Manesar, Gurugram.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner suffered a gun-shot injury at the time of his encounter at the hands of the Police. He is suffering from multiple problems in furtherance of the encounter, and therefore, seeks the concession of interim bail to get treatment.

3. The learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, contends that the petitioner is a habitual offender with multiple cases registered against him. As per the allegations, the petitioner and his co-

accused had gone and committed two murders inside the liquor vend. Multiple persons were also injured. The petitioner is being provided adequate treatment while in custody. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.

4. Keeping in view the rival contentions of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the jail authorities to provide adequate medical treatment to the petitioner.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
