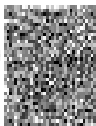
SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to fair, impartial and expeditious disposal of representations (Annexure P-1) & (Annexure P-3 to Annexure P-6) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, and that to take action in accordance with law against the respondent No.4 and other private respondents.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed the representation dated 30.01.2026 (Annexure P-5) before the respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The learned counsel prays for disposing of the present petition by issuing directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representation within the stipulated time.

3. **Notice of motion.**

4. Since advance notice has already been served upon the State, Mr.

Hence, service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-5), by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is, however, clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representation. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representation of the petitioner, and take an independent decision at his own level.
