SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (Oral)

1. The instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to take action against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for redressal of their grievance, the petitioner has already moved representation dated 28.01.2026 (Annexure P-8) before the respondent No.3- The Chief Director, Vigilance Bureau, Punjab Vigilance Bhawan, SAS Nagar Mohali, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that at this stage, for the purpose of the instant petition, the



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petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.3 to consider and pass an appropriate order on the representation of the petitioner dated 28.01.2026 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for State of Punjab submits that the aforesaid representation will be considered in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 28.01.2026 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law by passing an appropriate order, within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. Copy of the order so passed be also communicated to the petitioner as well.
