The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing respondent no.2 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 13.10.2025, Annexure P-3, for his transfer in any Government college within the rural area nearby district Rohtak to complete the mandatory rural area service for higher pay scale.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to decide his pending representation, dated 13.10.2025, within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the pending representation, dated 13.10.2025, will be decided by respondent no.1/Principal



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Secretary, Higher Education Department, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of two months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
