1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (formerly Section 482 Cr.P.C.) seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 5 to consider and decide the representation dated 13.05.2026 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action against respondents No. 6 to 8. A further prayer has been made for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 6 to 8 and their associates, who are allegedly extending constant threats to the petitioners and threatening to implicate them in false criminal cases.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 13.05.2026 (Annexure P-1), within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sushil Bhardwaj, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the

respondent-State and submits that the representation dated 13.05.2026 (Annexure P-1) is presently under inquiry.

5. Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab is directed to consider the representation dated 13.05.2026 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.

6. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

7. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
