1. Present petition has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 not to demolish the residential house of the petitioner, which was constructed/inherited by the petitioner approx. 20-22 years ago.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is living in her ancestral house situated at Ward No.2, Street No.13, Guru Ram Dass Nagar, Moga. He submits that sons of the petitioner are involved in drug cases and on account of the same, the State-authorities are bent upon demolishing the house of the petitioner without an fault on the part of the petitioner. He submits that for the redressal of her grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 22.05.2026 (Annexure P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga but the same has not been taken into consideration till date and daily, the Police is raiding the house of the petitioner.
