1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents to grant emergency medical parole to the petitioner for a period of 60 days as the petitioner is seriously ill and is under medical treatment at Pt. B.D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak.”
2. The petitioner who has completed his parole on 05.05.2026 is aggrieved by non-extension of parole.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that the petitioner was granted 70 days parole.
4. There is no denial of the fact that parole has a upper time limit and on the face of it there is no arbitrariness on behalf of the State. However, attention has been drawn to Page No.17 & 18 which is a report by Pt. B.D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak and on page No.18, just above the stamp, the doctor has stated that the patient be admitted on 12.05.2026, however, he was not admitted and was in custody.
5. Given the above, the State authorities are directed to provide him proper medical treatment and in case of admission, the decision will be taken by the doctors and the jail authorities will cooperate.

4. Regarding parole, petitioner is at liberty to file fresh after citing the relevant rules and judicial precedents, which would entitle him for parole even after completing his maximum period. In case, the petitioner files such application, it shall be decided strictly in accordance with law and not based on any observation made by this Court.
5. Given above, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty aforesaid. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
