This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 for issuance of Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondent No. 2 to decide the representation bearing no. 814048-PGD, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar dated 14.05.2026 (Annexure P-2) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No. 3 and 4 and his associates, stooges and to not interfere in life of petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners have preferred a complaint dated 14.05.2026 Annexure P-2 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar Punjab but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police,



Amritsar Punjab to look into his complaint and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

- 3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
- 4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S.Pandher, Asstt.AG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
- 6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the prayer made by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar Punjab to consider and decide the complaint 14.05.2026 Annexure P-2 of the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and pass an appropriate order.
