Application is allowed, as prayed for.

1. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner, restricts his argument only to the extent that a *mandamus* may be passed upon learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-II, Faridabad, before which is an application preferred by the petitioner under Order IX Rule 13 CPC is pending, to decide the same most expeditiously.

2. He further submits that a prayer for an interim direction, for staying the operation of the *ex parte* Award till the disposal of the said application, has also been made before the learned Industrial Tribunal.

3. Since a *bona fide* and *innocuous* prayer has been made by learned counsel for the petitioner, therefore, at this stage, without issuing notice of motion, this Court directs the learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-II, Faridabad, to make its all endeavours to decide the application under Section IX Rule 13 CPC most expeditiously, and also to take a decision on the prayer made for interim stay, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, after giving due opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.

4. **Disposed of** accordingly.
