JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to take an appropriate action with respect to illegal and unauthorized construction of building by respondent No.5.

2. Learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1-Society is headed by an 80 years old man. The petitioners are neighbour of respondent No.5 who is going to construct a commercial building without seeking approval of Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana. The petitioners have made representations to Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana but to no avail.

3. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 4 submits that Competent Authority would look into the matter and take requisite &

appropriate steps.

4. Learned counsel representing the petitioners agrees with the aforesaid arrangement.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands ***disposed of***. It is hereby made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on merits of the case.
