The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with the prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari/Mandamus, directing the Respondents to decide the Representation dated 04.02.2026 (Annexure P-7) & reminder representation dated 19.03.2026 (Annexure P-9) for claim for compassionate Appointment in accordance with applicable policy by passing a speaking order within a stipulated period of time.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Rajiv Verma, Addl. AG. Punjab, having served with an advance copy of the petition, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent/State and assures the Court that the above-said representations will be decided within time bound manner.
