KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 08.01.2026, this Court had passed the following order:-

“A perusal of the zimini orders reflects that none had caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner, consecutively on the last two occasions. The position is not any different even today.

In view of the above, let Court notice be issued to the petitioner, for 06.04.2026.”

2. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved, for want of correct address. In such circumstances, it is not feasible to adjudicate the matter. Moreover, since none is appearing on behalf of the petitioner, it seems that, with the efflux of time, petitioner has lost interest in pursuing the *lis*.

3. In view the above, the instant writ petition is **dismissed for want of prosecution**. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to get this petition revived by moving an apt motion/application.
