1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 03.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) and subsequent proceedings alongwith charge-sheet dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-8). It was prayed in the abovesaid writ petition that the respondents may be directed to hold the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the final decision of the criminal case as the criminal case was initiated on identical charges.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioner has been convicted, as such, nothing survives in the present writ petition and the same may be dismissed as infructuous.
