SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case Fir No. 30 dated 30.04.2025, under Sections 21(c), 25, 27, 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda Punjab.

2. In the present case, there is an alleged recovery of 2,500 intoxicating tablets containing the salt **Tramadol Hydrochloride** from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since **30.04.2025**. Considering the nature and quantity of the contraband allegedly recovered and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court does not find any ground to extend the concession of regular bail to the petitioner at this stage. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

3. However, it would be open to the petitioner to file a fresh petition seeking the concession of regular bail, in the event the trial is not



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concluded despite the petitioner having undergone **one year and six months of actual incarceration**, subject to there being no material change in the circumstances attributable to the petitioner.

4. Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the learned trial Court concerned for information and necessary compliance.
