KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to the action of the respondents in ignoring the petitioner while allotment of government accommodation (Type -IV).

2. He also seeks a *mandamus* upon the respondents to take departmental action against the erring officers/officials, who have committed irregularities while allotting government accommodation to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that so far as the payer for allotment of the government accommodation is concerned, same has been rendered infructuous, as the petitioner upon attaining the age of superannuation has already retired from service. However, she insists upon for issuance of a directions upon the respondents to take action against the erring officers/officials, who have

committed irregularities, and have flouted the rules, while not allotting the government accommodation to the petitioner as per his entitlement.

4. Since the first and main prayer of the petitioner, has been rendered infructuous, therefore, the instant petition is **dismissed** as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner, that if he is of the view that some irregularities have been committed by some officers/officials while allotting government accommodation, he can make complaint(s), to the authorities concerned, who are to take apposite action in this regard, at the first instance.

6. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
