1. Prayer in this petition is for directing the official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents Nos.4 to 6 and further for directing the respondents not to harass or interfere at the instance of private respondents who are annoyed from marriage of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. Marriage certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners have filed representation dated 01.06.2026 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa.

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3. Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3, only.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to decide the representation dated 01.06.2026 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
6. Disposed of.
