



3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Shweta Nahata, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that aggrieved against the aforesaid order dated 04.09.2025 passed in *Sandeep Kumar’s case (supra)*, an intra-Court appeal bearing *LPA No. 122 of 2026*, titled “*State of Haryana and others Versus Sandeep Kumar and others*” stands filed, wherein notice of motion has been issued, but no interim order has been passed.
5. Taking into consideration that the similar issue has already been decided in the case of *Sandeep Kumar (supra)* and there is no interim order passed in intra-Court appeal bearing *LPA No. 122 of 2026*, the present writ petition is *disposed of* with a direction to the respondents to re-consider the case of petitioners for the purpose of undergoing Lower School Course of the year 2024 in terms of *Sandeep Kumar’s case (supra)*.
6. It is made clear that the orders passed in the present petition shall abide by the final decision in LPA-122-2026.
