NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the advertisement dated 04.08.2020 (Annexure P-4), issued by respondent No.1, for the recruitment to the post of Radiographer vide which the selection criteria to the said post has not been clarified, being wrong, illegal, arbitrary and against the settled provisions of law; further seeking setting aside the impugned action of respondent No.3 vide which the other candidates have been issued appointment letters to the post of Radiographer by ignoring the merits of the present petitioners as the names of the

petitioners figure in the provisional merit list (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.3; further seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to consider the candidature of the petitioners to the post of Radiographer.

2. After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars by attaching all the necessary documents such as academic qualifications of the petitioners etc.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
