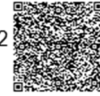

NEERJA K. KALSON, J.

1. This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and not to harass them in any manner against the wishes of petitioners and also directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 02.06.2026 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in a live-in-relationship. The private respondents are not accepting the said relationship and are extending threats to them. The copy of 'Aadhaar' cards and matriculation certificate (Annexures P-1 to P-4) of petitioners No.1 and 2 have been placed on record.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. Without commenting upon the validity of the said relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla to consider the representation dated 02.06.2026 (Annexure P-5) and take requisite action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter in accordance with law.

6. Pending application(s), if any, stand (s), disposed of accordingly.
