For the reasons stated, application is allowed. The date of hearing is advanced to today itself, and the main case is taken on Board.

CWP-20155-2022

The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a direction to the respondents to pay minimum of pay scale to the petitioners as eligible Extension Lecturers since they have become eligible for the post by obtaining the Ph.D. degrees and qualifying the National Eligibility Test (NET), with effect from their respective dates of acquiring the eligibility.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the Government has taken a decision vide memo, dated 04.05.2026, that those Extension Lecturers who have acquired eligibility of NET/Ph.D. from 04.03.2020 to 30.06.2023, will be granted monthly remuneration of ₹57,700



with effect from 14.12.2023, i.e., the date of notification of the amended policy. She further submits that in terms therewith, due benefits will be released to the petitioners within three months.

3. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of with liberty to the petitioners, who may be aggrieved with the aforesaid memo, to challenge the same.
4. Ordered accordingly.
